- Current Enlisted member or Company Grade Officer in the Idaho Air National Guard
- AF Form 24, Application for Appointment (Dated: Jun 2010)
- AF Form 422 W/State Air Surgeon Stamp
- AF Form 2030, Drug/Alcohol Abuse Certificate (Dated: Nov 2012)
- AF Form 357, Dependent Care (If Applicable, Dated: Mar 2015)
- Copy of unofficial transcripts (Graduate, Undergraduate, Etc...)
- Current passing PT Test
- Records Review (VMPF RIP)
- CV/Resume
- 1 Page MFR indicating the omission of any required documents
- Copies of ALL State Medical Licenses (Current and/or Expired)
- Registered nurse applicants must be a graduate of an baccalaureate degree program in nursing, which is accredited by a nationally recognized nursing accrediting agency. IAW AFI 36-2005, Paragraph 6.3.1.2.4., nursing accreditation agencies recognized by the US Department of Education meets the criteria for nationally recognized accrediting agency.
