The 124th Medical Group is looking for an exceptional Physician Assistant who would like to be a part of the Air National Guard Biomedical Clinician Utilization Field. As an ANG Physician Assistant you will perform primary medical care and clinical duties with the direction of a physician. The Biomedical Clinician Utilization Field encompasses the functions of physical and occupational therapy, clinical psychology and social work, optometry, podiatry, physician assistants, audiology, and speech pathology in support of and serves as an integral part of the medical career area and medical services.

Qualified applicants will meet/submit the following:

- Current Enlisted member or Company Grade Officer in the Idaho Air National Guard or eligible to become a member of the Idaho ANG.
- For entry into this specialty, graduation from a Physician Assistant training program accredited by the Accreditation Review Commission on Education for the Physician Assistant (ARC-PA) or its predecessors and acceptable to the Surgeon General, USAF, is mandatory. Certification by the National Commission on Certification of Physician Assistants is required.
- AF Form 24, Application for Appointment as Reserves of AF or USAF with-out component.
- AF Form 2030, Drug & Alcohol Abuse Certificate.
- Prior service documentation (Oath of Office, Promotion Orders, RIP, NGB 22, PCARS, etc.)
- Current passing PT Test (If Applicable)
- Consolidated Certified Transcripts of College Credits or Professional Training – Copies Only (All Colleges listed on AF 24)
- Copies of ALL State Medical Licenses (Current and/or expired)
- Last 3 EPR/OPR & Current Resume (CV)
- Applications from individuals currently in a PA program on track to graduate by August 2017

Anyone that is selected will have to have their application package reviewed and approved by NGB before they are commissioned
